Constitution of India

No.:GS-82-18-CRR-1179-81-114-G-2:-In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to the article 309 of the Constitution of India, and in supersession of all existing the rules regulating the the recruitment for appointment to the post of **Peon** in the non-Secretariate Offices, the Governor of Gujarat hereby makes the following rules to provide for regulating recruitment to the post of peon in the Interior non-Secretariat Service, namely:-

1. These Rules may be called the Peon (Non-Secretariat) Recruitment Rules 1982.
2. Appointment in to the post of peon called the Peon (Non-Secretariat) service shall be made either;
 - (a) by transfer of Hamal who has rendered at least three years continuation service in the cadre and possess the qualifications prescribed in clause (ii) of rule 3; or
 - (b) by direct selection.
3. To be eligible for appointment by direct selection to the post mentioned in rule 2, a candidate must:-
 - (i) not be less than 18 years of age and not more than 25 years of age;
 - (ii) have passed fourth standard.
4. The selected candidate shall be required to pass an examination in Gujarati or Hindi or both in accordance with the rules prescribed by the Government in that behalf from time to time.
