Constitution of India:

No:GH-SH-(06)-SCT-1292-C-132-GH:-In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India the Government of Gujarat hereby makes the following rules to provide for regulating recruitment to the post of Programmer (Computers) in Gujarat Educational Service, Class-II (Non Teaching), for Government Polytechnic under the Directorate of Technical Education, Gujarat State, namely;

1. These rules may be called the Programmer, Class-II Recruitment Rules, 1993.
2. Appointment to the post of Programmer (Computers) Class-II in Government Polytechnics in Gujarat Educational Service Class-II (Collegiate Branch) shall be made by direct selection.
3. To be eligible for direct selection to the post mentioned in rule 2,a candidate must:-
 - (a) not more than 35 years of age:
 - (b) Possess (i) Master's Degree atleast with Second Class in Computer Application or its equivalent of recognised university ; or
(ii) A Second class Bachelor's degree in Computer application of recognised university or its equivalent with above one years experience of Computer Programming in the Government Organisation and / or Institution recognized by the Government; or
(iii) A second class post graduate Diploma in Computer Application of a recognised Board or Institute with about one years experience of Computer Programming in the Government organization and / or Institution recognised by the Governments or
(iv) A second class diploma in Computer Engineering / Technology of a recognised Board or Institute with about two years experience of Computer Programming in Government organisations and / or institution recognised by the Government:

Provided that the Upper age limit may be relaxed in favour of a candidate who is already in the service of the Government of Gujarat in accordance with the provisions of the Gujarat Civil Services Classification and Recruitment (General) Rules 1967, as amended from time to time.

Provided further that the upper age limit may be relaxed in favour of a candidate who possess exceptionally good qualification or experience or both.

Note:- In case of post - graduate degree (by papers) the minimum duration of Post - graduate course will be considered towards acceptable experience.

(3) (c) Possess adequate knowledge of Gujarati and / or Hindi or both so as to be able to teach the subject concerned through either of these mediums.

4. A candidate appointed by direct selection shall be on probation for a period of two years.

5. A selected candidate shall be required to pass departmental examination, if any and an examination in Gujarati, or Hindi or both in accordance with the rules prescribed in that behalf by the Government from time to time.

6. A candidate appointed shall be required to undergo such training as may be prescribed in that behalf by the Government from time to time.

7. The selected candidates shall be imparted training at Government cost shall be required to furnish the security and surety bond in such form and for such amount and for such period as may be prescribed, by the Government from time to time.
